

Gregg and Julie Nicholson live in Bangkok, Thailand where Gregg does church planting and leadership training. Julie teaches special education at a prominent international school. They have four children, Joy, David, Sarah, and Grace. This is a portion of their recent newsletter.

Hello from Bangkok,

These are just a few of the highlights of things that have happened over the past few months. We are all excited about our summer trip to the U.S. We will be traveling a lot during the seven weeks we are there, and can't wait to see family. We hope to see many if you too. One of the main reasons for coming is to visit possible universities for Joy to consider as she enters her senior year this fall. Here in Thailand, the entire nation is still mourning at the passing of their King last October. For an entire year; everyone in the nation is wearing black and white to commemorate his life and death. Read on and see how God is at work here in Bangkok.

Bangna Christian Fellowship

As I mentioned in our last prayer letter, we were in the process of building our new facility that is a partnership between our church and a Thai Christian businessman's sports complex. After renting for almost 10 years, God opened the door for us to partner with this businessman who has a heart for church planting.

Bombing, Beating, and Burning Christians

Raffia came to our door tonight crying and carrying her one year old son. She's in her early thirties and she and her family have lived in our neighborhood for the past year. She said they had no money to buy even drinking water, and she asked for help. Raffia is in a foreign country; she's also three months pregnant and her husband was recently arrested and is now in the immigration prison for overstaying his visa. Raffia with her husband and about ten others from her extended family, fled Pakistan two years ago after their family experienced multiple threats and several family members were beaten by radical Muslims. Her husband's family owned a successful department store and after the community realized it was owned by Christians, they were persecuted. They left Pakistan because they feared for their lives. On one hand, just like America, Thailand can't just allow refugees to come into their country illegally. However, these Christians feel if they return to their home country they will be killed. This is a global issue so we ask for your prayers for the Pakistani Christians and for the persecuted Christians worldwide.
